

**DEFENCE FORCE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL**

**DETERMINATION NO. 18 OF 1999**

**SALARY PROTECTION PROVISION– AIRFIELD DEFENCE GUARDS**

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*:

**Commencement**

1. This Determination commences on 22 December 1999.

**Amendment**

2. Determination No. 6 of 1992, Salaries, as amended, is amended as set out in this Determination.

**New clause 11G (Salary protection provision – transfers to Airfield Defence Guard to meet a short term organisational need)**

3. Insert the following clause:

“11G.1 A member who is transferred from an existing employment category to undergo Airfield Defence Guard training and subsequent transfer to the Ground Defence Reserve Group (Operations) as an Airfield Defence Guard to meet a shortfall in establishment, will be entitled, where the transfer is approved by the Chief of the Defence Force, to salary at the rate that would have been otherwise payable, where that rate is a higher rate than for an Airfield Defence Guard.

11G.2 This clause ceases to have effect on 1 July 2001.”
