

# **DEFENCE FORCE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL**

## **DETERMINATION NO. 22 OF 2003**

### **ARMY COMBAT CLERK AND STOREMAN CATEGORIES – TEMPORARY UPGRADE FOR CERTAIN MEMBERS**

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*:

#### **Commencement**

- 1.1 This Determination is to be taken to have commenced on 2 October 2003.
- 1.2 This Determination ceases on 30 December 2003.

#### **Definition**

2. In this Determination:

“commencement day” means 2 October 2003;

“Determination No. 6 of 1992” means Determination No. 6 of 1992, Salaries, as amended;

“pay group” has the same meaning as in Determination No. 6 of 1992.

#### **Member this Determination applies to**

3.1 This Determination applies to a member of the Army who, on the day before the commencement day, was remunerated in Pay Group 4 for the purposes of Determination No. 6 of 1992, while the member occupied a position in one of the following employment categories:

- (a) Combat Clerk, Infantry;
- (b) Manager Clerk, Infantry;
- (c) Manager Storeman, Infantry;
- (d) Storeman, Infantry;
- (e) Supervisor Clerk, Infantry;
- (f) Supervisor Storeman, Infantry.

3.2 This Determination also applies to a member of the Army who, on the day before the commencement day, was remunerated in Pay Group 5 for the purposes of Determination No. 6 of 1992, while the member:

- (a) was a Staff Sergeant or Warrant Officer Class 2 in the Royal Australian Infantry; and
- (b) occupied a position of Combat Clerk or Storeman in the Royal Australian Infantry; and
- (c) was qualified as a Supervisor Infantry Operations.

**Temporary upgrade**

4. For the period between the commencement day and the day that this Determination ceases, the member is entitled to be remunerated under Determination No. 6 of 1992 as if the member’s employment category were included in:

- (a) for a member that subclause 3.1 applies to — Pay Group 4; and
- (b) for a member that subclause 3.2 applies to — Pay Group 5.
