DETERMINATION NO. 16 OF 2005

PARATROOPER ALLOWANCE - AMENDMENT

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*:

Commencement

1. This Determination commences on 26 October 2005.

Amendment

2. Determination No. 2 of 2001, Paratrooper Allowance, is amended as set out in this Determination.

Clause 3 (Paratrooper Allowance – member on continuous full-time service)

3. Substitute:

“3. A member who is a paratrooper rendering continuous full-time service is entitled to Paratrooper Allowance at the rate that applies to them in the table.

6.	posted to any of these: (a) 3RAR (Parachute) Battalion Group. (b) 4RAR (Commando). (c) Parachute Training School. (d) 1 Commando Regiment.	\$2,922 a year

	(e) 126 Commando Signal Squadron. (f) the Special Air Service Regiment. (g) a comparable overseas parachute unit specified by the CDF.	
7.	posted to any other parachute unit, including a comparable overseas parachute unit not conducting tactical parachute operations	\$1,462 a year
8.	any other member who is required to perform a parachute descent	\$30.46 for each descent (up to a limit of 30 descents a year).

Clause 5 (Paratrooper Allowance – member of the Reserve Forces)

4. Substitute:

“5. A member of the Reserve Forces who is a paratrooper is entitled to Paratrooper Allowance, for each day or part of a day the member renders Reserve service, at the rate that applies to them in the table.

5.	a Free Fall paratrooper performing the duties of a Free Fall paratrooper at any unit conducting parachute operations	\$9.67 a day
6.	posted to any of these: (a) 3RAR (Parachute) Battalion Group. (b) 4RAR (Commando). (c) Parachute Training School. (d) 1 Commando Regiment. (e) 126 Commando Signal Squadron. (f) the Special Air Service Regiment. (g) a comparable overseas parachute unit specified by the CDF.	\$8.00 a day

7.	posted to any other parachute unit, including a comparable overseas parachute unit not conducting tactical parachute operations	\$4.00 a day
8.	any other member who is required to perform a parachute descent	\$30.46 for each descent (up to a limit of 30 descents a year).

Paragraph 6.5 (a) (Allowance not payable)

4. Substitute:

“(a) for a member to whom item 1, 2, 2A, 3 or 23 of the Schedule applies — nil; and”.
