

DEFENCE FORCE REMUNERATION TRIBUNAL

DETERMINATION NO. 17 OF 2006

SALARY RATES FOR SENIOR OFFICERS 07 AND 08 SALARIES

The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal makes the following Determination under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*:

Commencement

1. This Determination commences on the date of signature.

Amendment

2. Determination No.6 of 1992, Salaries, as amended, is amended as set out in this Determination.

Clause 13 (Rate of salary for senior officer)

- 3.1 Omit:

“13. The rate of salary applicable to a senior officer with the rank of Brigadier or above is the rate specified in column 2 of Part 1 of Schedule 2, opposite the officer’s rank in column 1.”.

- 3.2 Insert:

“13.1 This clause does not apply to the following classes of senior officer.

- (a) An officer who may be paid salary at a rate specified under Part 2 of this Determination.
- (b) A specialist officer who may be paid salary at a rate specified for:
 - (i) a chaplain; or
 - (ii) a dental officer; or
 - (iii) a legal officer; or
 - (iv) a medical officer.
- (c) A statutory office holder to whom salary is payable under a determination made by the Remuneration Tribunal.
- (d) An officer who holds the position of Chief Capability Development.

13.2 The annual rate of salary applicable to a senior officer with a rank listed in column 2 of Part 1 of Schedule 2 is the base rate specified for that rank in column 3 of Part 1 of Schedule 2.

13.3 The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal may determine that an individual senior officer is to be paid salary at a rate up to the maximum rate of salary for rank and Force in Schedule 2, to recognise additional work value.

13.4 For any period that salary is payable under this clause, a senior officer is not to be paid an amount of allowance for qualification and skill under any of the following Determinations.

- (a) Determination No. 9 of 1995, Submarine Service Allowance.
- (b) Determination No. 4 of 2006, Flying and Flight Duties Allowance.
- (c) Determination No. 11 of 2002, Special Action Forces Allowance.
- (d) Determination No. 19 of 2002, Specialist Operations Allowance.”.

Clause 17 (Rate of salary - member other than officer), title only

4. Substitute clause title:

“Rate of salary - member below the rank of Warrant Officer Class 1”

Clause 22 (Rate of salary - officer of the Reserve Forces)

5.1 Omit:

“22. The rate of salary applicable to a senior officer of the Reserve Forces with the rank of Brigadier or above is the rate specified in column 2 of Part 2 of Schedule 2, opposite the officer’s rank in column 1.”.

5.2 Insert:

“22.1 This clause does not apply to the following classes of senior officer.

- (a) An officer who may be paid salary at a rate for a specified appointment listed in Schedule 12.
- (b) A specialist officer who may be paid salary at a rate specified for:
 - (i) a chaplain; or
 - (ii) a dental officer; or
 - (iii) a legal officer; or
 - (iv) a medical officer.

- (c) A statutory office holder to whom salary is payable under a determination made by the Remuneration Tribunal.
- (d) An officer who holds the position of Chief Capability Development.

22.2 The daily rate of salary applicable to a senior officer of the Reserve Forces with a rank listed in column 2 of Part 2 of Schedule 2 is the base rate specified for that rank in column 3 of Part 2 of Schedule 2.

22.3 The Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal may determine that an individual senior officer is to be paid salary at a rate up to the maximum rate of salary for their rank and Force in Schedule 2.

22.4 For any period that salary is payable under this clause, a senior officer is not to be paid an amount of allowance for qualification and skill under any of the following Determinations.

- (a) Determination No. 9 of 1995, Submarine Service Allowance.
- (b) Determination No. 4 of 2006, Flying and Flight Duties Allowance.
- (c) Determination No. 11 of 2002, Special Action Forces Allowance.
- (d) Determination No. 19 of 2002, Specialist Operations Allowance.”.

Clause 26 (Rate of salary - member other than officer), title only

6. Substitute clause title:

“Rate of salary - member of the Reserve Forces below the rank of Warrant Officer Class 1”

Schedule 2 (Salary rates for senior officers)

7. Substitute Schedule 2 with the Schedule in the Attachment to this Determination.
