## TRANSITION ARRANGEMENTS FOR 09/010 OFFICERS

(Matter 4 of 2019)

- This statement should be read in conjunction with our previous statement in regard to O9 and O10 senior officer transition arrangements which was issued on 20 September 2017.<sup>1</sup> At that time we set remuneration arrangements for five specified O9 and O10 officers<sup>2</sup> during their transition from the Permanent Force and resignation, retirement or transfer to the Reserves.
- [2] The recent establishment of three additional O9 level appointments has caused the Australian Defence Force (ADF) to seek to extend the transitional salary provisions made for those select officers to the post-appointment management of <u>all</u> O9 and O10 senior officers transitioning from the ADF.<sup>3</sup> This proposal was supported by the Commonwealth.<sup>4</sup>
- [3] As agreed in our previous considerations<sup>5</sup> of these officers and given the demanding nature of the appointments at these ranks and the constraints on their time while in the role, we agree to determine the same post-appointment transition arrangements for all O9 and O10 officers.

[4] Determination 4 of 2019 gives effect to this decision from 31 July 2019.
