# Schedule 1—Amendment

# DFRT Determination No. 2 of 2017, Salaries

# 1 Subsection B.2.3.5 (Pay grade for an officer)

After subsection B.2.3.5, insert:

- 5A. If subsection 5 applies to a member and the member ceases to hold a Command Appointment, subsection 5 continues to apply to the member if all of the following conditions apply.
  - a. The officer has served a minimum of 12 months in the Command Appointment.
  - b. The officer was not removed from the Command Appointment due to poor performance, inappropriate behaviour, disciplinary action or adverse administrative action.
- 5B. The CDF may determine that a member has met the conditions under subsection 5A if the member serves less than 12 months in the Command Appointment for service reasons.
