4 Subclause B.1.3.2 (Rate of salary for a senior officer)

Delete subclause B.1.3.2 in its entirety and insert:

"2. A senior officer who is a dental officer is to be paid the rate of salary under Part 1 or 2 of Schedule B.16, listed for the officer's Force, rank and dental level."

5 Clause B.3.2 (Definitions)

Delete the table in clause B.3.2 in its entirety and insert the table at Schedule 1 to this Determination.

6 Subclause B.3.3.1 (Rate of salary for specialist officer)

Delete the table in subclause B.3.3.1 in its entirety and insert the table at Schedule 2 to this Determination.

7 Schedule B.6 (Specialist Officer – Dental Officer)

Delete Schedule B.6 in its entirety and insert the schedule at Schedule 3 to this Determination.

8 Schedule B.16 (Senior Officer – Dental Officer)

Delete Schedule B.16 in its entirety and insert the schedule at Schedule 4 to this Determination.
