EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Defence Force Remuneration Tribunal Determination No. 10 of 2026, Navy Maritime Logistics Officer

This Determination amends DFRT Determination No. 2 of 2017, Salaries (the Salaries Determination), made under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903* (the Act) and in accordance with subsection 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901* (AI Act). The Principal Determination sets out provisions dealing with salary for members of the Australian Defence Force (ADF).

The purpose of this Determination is to recognise the increasingly demanding and complex roles performed by Intermediate Mastery stage Maritime Logistic Officers. It also recognises the alignment between Navy Mastery and employment category positions in developing suitably qualified and experience personnel capable of delivering Defence-wide capability effects.

Section 1 of this Determination sets out the manner in which this Determination may be cited.

Section 2 of this Determination provides that the Determination commences 24 September 2026.

Section 3 provides that this instrument has authority under section 58H of the *Defence Act 1903*.

Section 4 provides that each instrument that is specified in a Schedule to this instrument is amended or repealed as set out in the applicable items in the Schedule concerned, and any other item in a Schedule to this instrument has effect according to its terms.

Schedule 1—Navy Maritime Logistics Officer amendments

Item 1 amends table item 11 to pay grade 3 of Part 2 to Schedule B.2 of the Salaries Determination. The item changes the classification of Maritime Logistics Officers in pay grade 3 from 'primary qualification' to 'foundational'.

Item 2 inserts a new item after item 7 of pay grade 4 of Part 2 to Schedule B.2 of the Salaries Determination. The new item adds Maritime Logistics Officers with an 'intermediate' classification to pay grade 4.

Item 3 amends table item 13 to pay grade 5 of Part 2 to Schedule B.2 of the Salaries Determination. The item changes the classification of Maritime Logistics Officers in pay grade 5 from 'charge qualified' to 'intermediate plus'.
